- Charles Heidsieck Brut Réserve, Champagne** [WSE93]
France
Ripe fruits and velvety cream with crisp acidity and persistent bubbly finish. **\$365**
- Ponte-48 Millesimato Brut, Prosecco Rose, 2020**
Italy
"Prosecco Doc" Rose, from north of Venice / Treviso. A fresh and pleasant fruity nose and palette. Balanced acidity with the right level of juice and vitality. **\$145**
- Zonin Prosecco Spumante Brut, Cuvee 1821** [WSE86]
Italy
Fruity with a touch of citrus. Refreshing chilled. **\$155**
- Delamotte Brut Champagne** [WE90]
France
A very good Champagne at a reasonable price. Vibrant bubbles with notes of fresh apple and citrus. Most enjoyable. **\$265**

White

- Auntsfield, Sauvignon Blanc, 2021** [WSE88]
Marlborough, New Zealand
Intense ripe fruit flavours of nectarine and white peach with citrus notes of ripe grapefruit and mandarin peel balanced by an underlying minerality. **\$145**
- Alpha Zeta, Pinot Grigio S.V. "Terrapieno", 2020**
Italy
Clean, crisp and fresh with baked bread crust perfumes and ripe juicy pear character. **\$120**
- Bellingham Bernard Series Old Vine Chenin Blanc, 2018** [WSE90]
South Africa
Excellent vintage from mature bush vines. 100% Chenin Blanc. A lavish concentration of fruit flavours. Powerful, but pleasant spicy complexity on the palate. **\$230**
- Dom Vincent Dampt Chablis Les Lys 1st Cru, 2019** [WSE90]
France
A Chardonnay which is sharp and crisp, a typical Chablis. A green and fruity white wine. **\$308**
- Tardieu-Laurent, Côtes-du-Rhône Les Becs Fins, 2019** [WS90]
Southern Rhone, France
A medium-bold wine blend. Rich, fruity and aromatic. Delicious. Enjoy more. **\$145**
- Olivier Leflaive Montagny, Bonneveaux 1er Cru, 2019** [WSE90]
France
An elegant rich Chardonnay. Dry, medium bodied with an acidic edge. A lovely buttery taste, full and round with mineral notes, spices, and nuts. **\$340**
- Dom Neumeyer, Gewurztraminer Taureau-Stierkopf 2017** [WSE89]
Alsace, France
Gewurztraminer, a pink grape producing wines with a rich flowery aroma. Tastes a little sweet with low acidity and a long dry finish with good body. Very moreish and pairs well with cheese, seafood, and Asian cuisine. **\$190**

White Wines of Distinction

- Brokenwood ILR Semillon, 2011** [WSE92]
Hunters Valley, Australia
A superb white wine, light bodied, dry and a fine vintage. 100% Semillon with a drinking window from 2019 to 2041. Fine, flinty acid that revives and lingers longer after the initial sip. **\$470**

- Chateau Talbot Caillou Blanc, 2018** [WA91]
Medoc, France
Medium to full-bodied, the palate is ripe and seductive with freshness and a long tropical finish. **\$385**

Red

- Altos Las Hormigas Reserve, Malbec, 2018** [JS94]
Mendoza, Argentina
A complex Malbec. A pleasant nose of violet, fresh fruit. An elegant length balanced and very drinkable with chalky caressing tannins. **\$225**
- Torbreck, Woodcutters Shiraz, 2019** [WSE90]
Barossa Valley, Australia
A highly rated Torbreck wine at a very reasonable price. This Shiraz is a "beautifully refined and punchy young red". **\$225**
- Penfolds, Bin 28 Shiraz, 2019** [WSE91]
Southern Australia
A unique blend of Shiraz grapes from various vineyards including McLaren Vale and Barossa Valley. A great Shiraz, full bodied, supple, concentrated, and lush with a rich velvety finish. **\$270**
- Penfolds, Bin 128 Coonawarra Shiraz, 2017** [FAL91]
Coonawarra, Australia
A medium bodied cool-climate Shiraz, silky tannins and lingering elegant finish. A semi-dry wine with a plummy taste and highlights of raspberries. Perfectly within its drinking window. **\$300**
- William Downie, Cathedral Pinot Noir, 2020**
Gippsland, Australia
An excellent light, easy drinking Pinot Noir from an excellent winery. Dry, red fruits, smooth with a slight acidic kick. A great social summer red wine. **\$270**
- Devil's Corner, Pinot Noir, 2019** [WSE88]
Tasmania, Australia
A Pinot Noir with a strong perfumed aroma redolent of spicy black cherry, dark fruits and hints of raspberries. A juicy sweet-fruit middle palate with soft ripe tannins and fresh acidity. An easy drinking wine to be enjoyed any time. **\$185**
- Château Bourgneuf, Pomerol, 2015** [WSE89]
Bordeaux (Right Bank), France
Classic Bordeaux from a Chateau known for its Merlot based grand vin. A delicious wine and excellent vintage. **\$425**
- Château des Eyrins, Margaux, 2012** [WSE89]
Bordeaux, France
A billowy bouquet, approachable and extremely satisfying. Opulent with a luscious texture of ample fruit and spice. **\$290**
- Olivier Leflaive, Volnay, 2013** [WS89/RP88/WSE89]
Burgundy, France
Ripe berry and cherry fruits with floral edge, medium bodied, luscious and minerality to finish. **\$345**
- Dom de la Ville "Inspiration", 2018** [WSE86]
Crozes-Hermitage, France
A bio-dynamic wine, 100% Syrah. A complex and yet harmonious bouquet and an excellent palate of fruit, high on drinkability with tannins really well in step. **\$180**
- Château Croix Cardinale Grand Cru, St Emilion, 2011** [WS91]
Bordeaux, France
A predominantly Merlot-Cabernet Franc blend. Rich tannic structure balanced by characteristics of plum and black cherry along with chocolate and sweet spice. **\$350**
- Château Auzias Instinct Terrien, 2017** [DEC98]
Languedoc, France
A blend of Cabernet Franc, Syrah, and Grenache. A local favourite, great value for money. A wine to be enjoyed, you will not be disappointed. **\$150**
- Les Vins de Vienne, Côtes-du-Rhône Les Cranilles 2019** [WSE86]
Southern Rhone, France
A medium-bold blend of Grenache, Mourvedre and Syrah. Rich, intense, slightly tannic, and dry with slight acidity **\$150**
- Chateau Bois de la Garde, 2017** [WSE89]
Rhone, France
Medium bodied with red fruits and spice. The wine is already open ending with a soft kirsch finish. **\$170**

G D Vajra Barbera D'Alba, 2019 [WSE88] Piedmont, Italy An elegant wine, powerful, rich, concentrated, and smooth, fruity taste	\$220
Gigi Bianco OVELLO Barbaresco, 2009/2011/2012/2013 [WSE90] Piedmont, Italy Four vintages of a classic elegant Barbaresco. Lighter than the "Pora". A clear well-structured wine. Full-bodied taste that continues to evolve. Tangy medium acidity. All vintages are drinking well, a good wine.	\$330
Gigi Bianco PORA, Barbaresco, 2010 [WSE90] Piedmont, Italy A robust Nebbiolo with a complex nose, nice acidity, and fine tannins with slight vintage variations. Smooth, long finish.	\$340
Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2019 [FAL91] Tuscany, Italy A very drinkable Super-Tuscan. Merlot provides a soft balance to the Sangiovese; plenty of fruit, structure and not too much tannin. An excellent wine.	\$220
Tenuta San Guido Le Difese, 2020 [JS92] Tuscany, Italy A juicy and delicious red with aromas of blueberries, sliced mushrooms, blackberry leaves, liquorice and bergamot. Medium bodied with fine tannins.	\$170
Chateau Musar, 2014 [WSE91] Bekaa Valley, Lebanon Deep red in colour, with aromas of sweet cherry, plum and dried fruit together with a subtle spice element and a hint of tobacco. The wine has a soft rounded feel and supported with soft, velvety tannins and a spicy finish.	\$350
Kanonkop Kadette Pinotage, 2018/2019 [WSE90] South Africa Nose of red berries and black plum, followed through to a taste of sweet spice and vanilla. Bold, dry with supple tannins.	\$170
Losada Mencia, 2018 [JS92] Bierzo, Spain Easy drinking, a pleasant light Mencia. Dense with dark berry, spice and liquorice flavours, An elegant long finish. Highly recommended	\$175
Borsao Tres Picos Garnacha, 2018 [WS90] Campo de Borja, Spain A well-structured, rich wine with aromas of ripe red fruit and a taste of dark fruits and vanilla with soft and silky tannins. 100% Grenache.	\$205
Vina Bujanda Gran Reserva, 2011 [WSE90] Rioja, Spain A beautifully smooth Tempranillo, elegant and complex nose of blackberry and plums. A fresh taste on the palate with a long elegant finish	\$230
Livius Tempranillo Rioja, 2010 [WSE91] Spain A highly rated Rioja, dry and intense but flavourful and easy to drink.	\$340
Pintia Vega Sicilia 2014 [WSE92] Toro, Spain An amazing and elegant Tempranillo. Medium-bold and big with delicate tannins embraced by fresh fruit and liquorice flavours. Incredibly smooth with a lingering taste.	\$410

Bouchard Pere et Fils Beaune du Chateau 1er Cru, 2018 [TA92] Cote du Beaune, France Complex nose of mixed berry fruits that introduce a rich, energetic medium-bodied wine with a punchy finish.	\$415
G D Vajra Barolo Albe, 2015 [WSE91] Piemonte, Italy A vintage of rich, vibrant Barolos. Albe is a pure tribute to Barolo di Barolo and the amazing craft of combining high-elevation estate vineyards, authentic and expressive. An elegant wine	\$430

Ch. Batailley, 5CC, Pauillac, 2016 [WSE91] Bordeaux (left Bank), France A classically styled Pauillac. A 5 th Growth which blends Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot. The wine is medium bodied with an elegant finish	\$555
Barone Ricasoli, Chianti Classico Reserva, 2016 [WS93] Tuscany, Italy A complex nose of mixed berry fruits, cherries and some tobacco that introduces a rich energetic medium bodied wine with a punchy finish. Smooth, elegant and solid.	\$565
Il Poggione, Brunello di Montalcino, 2016/2017 [WA95/ WSE93] Tuscany, Italy A highly rated Brunello. 100% Sangiovese. Warm, flavours, a touch of spice with velvet tannins. A beautiful Brunello.	\$325
Penfolds Bin 389 Cabernet Shiraz, 2019 [WSE92/FAL95] Southern Australia A flagship Penfolds blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (53%) and Shiraz (47%), referred to as "the Baby Grange". A wine blended from various vineyards. Its medium to full-bodied, rich and intense, silky in feel, with gentle drying tannins.	\$520
